CALL FOR SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER FACILITATORS

1. Name and address of the call 'manager'

The selection process will be monitored by the KBB partner consortium under supervision of SFG, A-8020 Graz, Nikolaiplatz 2.

2. Purpose and aim of the call

The aim of the call is to select individuals with technical and entrepreneurial background to be trained, licenced and hired to work with companies in a trial phase of a KBB project.

The group of selected individuals will be trained, licenced and invited to cooperate with companies in technology projects.

KBB partner consortium will proceed with the selection of candidates following the established process. The selected individuals will sign the contract with SFG after the training and licencing is successfully finished. The fees are to be subject to the intensity of work.

The process of training (organised in the premises of KBB partners in Slovenia and Austria) also involves assistance in organisation and participation in 6 events for companies from the region. Training and accompanying events will take place in the year of 2010.

KBB partner consortium represented by SFG will appoint technology transfer facilitators:

- To audit selected companies in order to define the technology project the company wishes to implement
- To use the KBB partner network in order to find adequate connections between technology/know-how demand and supply in the participating regions
- To coordinate and implement the technology project and support the company with their services

3. Subject of the call

Subject of the call is the selection of technology transfer facilitators to be put through training.

4. Conditions for applying (profile and requirements of the candidates)

All applicants are to be citizens of Republic of Austria. Candidates are expected to have a good knowledge of English language.

The application is to be prepared and turned in individually.

Candidates skills need to include experience in innovation projects and use of their applicable results in practice and in technology transfer.

They should be motivated to work in a company on an assigned project.

Prospective technology transfer facilitators are to have skills in at least one of the following thematic priorities:

- ICT
- New materials
- Biotechnology
- Chemistry
- Food technology
- Civil engineering
- Automotive
- Pharmacy
- Energy
- Environment
- Creative industries

5. Data protection and data assessment

Applications with all criteria met will be subject to further evaluation process by special commission. The commissions decision is final.

Applicant agrees with process and evaluation of his application upon its submission. The KBB partner consortium will take into account data protection measures.
